

Protection policy on domestic workers in Indonesia: Framing analysis of online media detik.com and kompas.com

Abstract

Cases of violence experienced by domestic workers increase every year. In the form of unpaid wages, termination of employment, to human trafficking which shows the weakness of human rights and protection in labor. Ideally, the government should have a law that protects domestic workers, but in fact the draft on the protection of domestic workers in Indonesia has been stagnant for 20 years. This study aims to look at the construction of news coverage of government policies on the protection of domestic workers on two online media, detik.com and Kompas.com. The data source is news documentation related to the protection policy for domestic worker in 2024. Data collection uses documentation or archiving, data analysis technique with framing analysis by Robert N. Entman. The news construction of domestic workers issues and policies has the result that the draft law on the protection already exist, but has not been ratified immediately. The actor in this news is the DPR RI, detik.com leads to the insistence on the ratification of the PPRT Bill. Meanwhile, Kompas.com leans towards performance that is considered slow through two points view. The moral message conveyed is that women with vulnerable conditions should get special attention from DPR RI. The solution offered by detik.com is the form of case investigation and approval of the bill to Prolegnas, while Kompas.com is the enthusiasm and commitment in discussing and passing the PPRT Bill. The implications are expected to encourage the authorities to pay attention and immediately pass a law protecting domestic workers.

Introduction

Domestic workers play an active role in the daily lives of Indonesian families. Domestic workers work in the household sector, doing work related to household affairs such as cooking, washing clothes, ironing, and so on. The main factor behind the presence of domestic workers are poverty and the need labor in the cosmetic sector that is imposed on women. Economic demands are big reason for a person to choose a job, such as

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escaping economic bondage and getting a job amid narrow employment opportunities. On the social aspect, this work is not considered a formal profession. The wages are based on the mercy and generosity of the employer [1].

The condition of domestic workers in Indonesia is still inadequate, in the form of being prone to exploitation, low wages, excessive workload, lack of health and social security, and even refers to acts of violence. Data from the National Household Advocacy Network or JALA PRT, as many 3,308 cases of violence befell domestic workers between 2021 and February 2024. Meanwhile, research by the International Labor Organization (ILO) in 2022 estimates 67.1 million people have jobs as domestic workers, and around 17.2% or 11.5 million people work outside their country [2].

Human trafficking is a risk that domestic workers, such as female domestic workers from East Nusa Tenggara face. Domestic workers come to big cities to make a living far from their hometown on the hope of earning a decent living. However, in truth domestic workers are subjected to actions that oppose their rights as workers. This includes unpaid employers and employment agencies [4]. This shows that domestic workers are in such a weak position that they are not recognized for their work, resulting in violence and exploitation that leads to the practice of human trafficking.

The wages of domestic workers in Indonesia are still considered low, ranging from Rp 1.8 million to 3.2 million depending on the province. With the scope of work of domestic workers get their rights in the form of holidays or leave, social and labor security, and appropriate wages. Ideally, this should be a special concern for the community and government in providing policies that protect the right of domestic workers. The national Network of Domestic Workers advocacy or JALA PRT proposes recognition in the PPRT Bill [5].

Through the various unfavorable conditions that domestic workers have to confront, ideally there should be protection that guarantees domestic workers from problem of low wages, unlimited working hours, unsupportive security, health and safety facilities, workloads that are prone to violence, the right to leave or holidays, and so on that lead to human rights violations. However, Indonesia does not yet have a law that directly protects domestic workers.

The closest law is Law No. 13/2003 on Manpower, which contains standard rights for workers. According to Law 13/2003, it states “A person who works and earns wages and or other forms of remuneration”. The law should cover domestic workers do not yet have a legal umbrella that regulate and protect domestic workers [1].

This illustrates that the actions experienced by domestic workers are detrimental to domestic workers, which is caused by the protection of domestic workers that is not given or regulated in the law. Through research conducted by Gilang in 2022 on the legal protection of domestic workers regarding working hours, in fact several existing regulations have not been able to accommodate the protection of domestic workers on

the issue of working hours. Incidents that befall domestic workers are allegedly due to the absence of a legal umbrella that regulates and protects this informal profession.

Protection for domestic workers in Indonesia has been drafted as a bill since 2004. However, with the current facts the draft law on protection of domestic workers, which has been stagnant for the past 20 years has become a shadow for domestic workers. This condition makes domestic workers required to work in inequality without a legal umbrella [6]. With the continuous coverage of the importance of the ratification of the PPRT Law, the media encourages the government and the legislature to be more serious in discussing and passing this draft law.

Considering this, the PPRT Bill is an important thing to be ratified immediately. With the hope that the passing of domestic workers protection act can be a breath of fresh air in cases that have occurred, as should be the basic rights of workers in legal protection [7]. several parties support the passing of the PPRT Bill, such as Komnas Perempuan which has high hopes for the ratification of this bill [3].

Framing was used in a study conducted by Graha Wira Krida in 2023 about the coverage of the draft Omnibus Health Law in online news. According to Graha, framing is used to frame news that is currently a topic of conversation for health workers and the public at large [8]. However, this has become a debate and chaos because there is no massive communication in the midst of this news.

Meanwhile, Arik Sofian in study entitled the coverage of government policies in handling Covid 19 cases in 2020, framing is used to see the other side of journalists seeing the situation that is being reported [9]. According to him, the tempo.com newspaper does not just share information in the form of ways not to contract covid-19. Instead, tempo.com criticizes the government's policies and attitudes when dealing with this outbreak. It can be seen from the headlines that show the pessimistic attitude of the media about the policies they choose.

This phenomenon has only researched using the point of view of legal studies and gender, no research has been found using communication study. So, to see the policy frame regarding the draft law in the media a framing analysis through communication perspective is needed. Policy framing is important to know the different ways of framing a news, namely the way journalists construct news on media portals [10]. In seeing the reality of news based on the news made by the media, framing can be a tool to select various interest that are used to influence issues so that they are raised in the media [11].

This issue is interesting because the media has an important role in voicing the aspirations of the media, namely as social control. The media has a very crucial role in voicing the aspirations of the community when they have not been heard or represented. As discussed by Rahmawati in a study entitled The Role of Mass Media in efforts to Prevent Corruption in Indonesia in 2024. Which shows that mass media plays a role as social control in the form of voicing the aspirations of the community. According to her, the media has a role in the form of a control tool as supervision,

correction, criticism, and suggestions that build legal certainty. As a result, it has a positive impact on optimal law enforcement on acts of corruption. And the media has a role in building cognitive effects, namely increasing awareness and knowledge, affective aspects related to feelings, emotions, and behavior, as well as connotative effects in the form of behavior or intention to do in a certain way [12].

Research on policy framing through mass media that acts as a control was conducted by Salmi Miftah regarding the framing analysis of face-to-face learning policies in the CNN Indonesia media, showing that the construction in media coverage of government policies during Covid-19 regarding the causes, triggers, consequences, and handling of the pandemic carried out by the government. Different from the findings of Herlina Muzanah regarding government policies related to the ban on the import of used clothes. This study only has the task of conveying information about government policies in the form of regulations prohibiting the import of used clothes and does not have a function in social control government.

Although this research has almost the same topic, Almira Khairunisa on the implementation of this research perspective journalism on the news of female immigration workers or domestic workers in online media focuses more on gender perspective in online media reporting. Like the previous research, this is interesting to study using framing analysis by Entman on the four elements.

This research is used to explore the process of framing news on online media, about domestic worker protection policies. To see how the online media detik.com and Kompas.com confuse or frame the news before it is presented to the public. This research is to find out how online media perceive the protection of domestic workers, explore the main actors who want to be highlighted in the news, the use of arguments that strengthen, to the solutions used as an effort to solve the problem. Based on these four things, it can show the integrity of the news framing of domestic worker protection policies in Indonesia.

Framing according to things that are highlighted or included from a news text. He emphasizes on the selection process of various aspects of reality so that events that are made news will be more highlighted than other aspects [13]. By looking at its influence on the formation of public opinion and policies related to the protection of domestic workers on the issue. Through framing initiated by Entman on the news of the PPRT Law, it can be used to reveal how the media presents the issue. Such as define problems, diagnose causes, make moral judgment, and treatment recommendation.

Define problems such as how the event or issue can be understood, same issue or event can be different ways due to different framing resulting in different realistic impacts. Then diagnose causes is to frame who is meant to be the actor of the issue or event occurred, the way in which events are understood will shape what and who is considered the source of the problem. Making moral judgments, which are things that

can be used to justify or provide arguments for defining the problem is found and requires strong argumentation in support of idea itself. The fourth element is treatment recommendation or emphasizing resolution, which is used in assessing what journalists want, such as what path is chosen to solve a problem.

Furthermore, these elements are tools used in news framing analysis in a media. The tendency or point of view of journalists in understanding events or issues can be understood through Entman's four framing elements. That is how journalists or media understand and define problem into news form, estimate the source of the problem or the problem itself, provide moral value in the form they want, and what kind solution is offered in writing news.

Methods

This research uses descriptive qualitative research which aims to describe systematically, accurately, and factually about the news related to domestic worker protection policies in Indonesia on online media detik.com and Kompas.com. Through the formulation of the problem, the analysis in this study is the text in the news about the protection policy of domestic workers in two online media. The object of the research in this study is related to the government's policy on the protection of domestic workers, because the media covers the news continuously along with the concern that the bill stagnates at the change of legislative members.

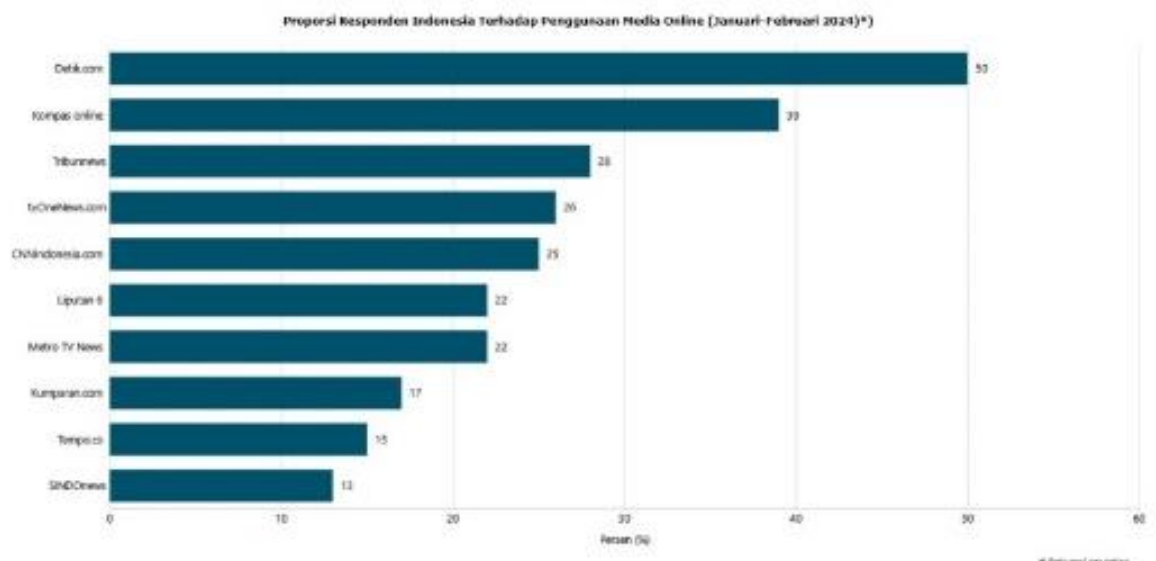


Figure 1. Online Media User Respondents by databoks

Through the communication side in the form of in-depth framing analysis to identify strategies used by online media detik.com and Kompas.com. Research chose the two online media, namely the Indonesian respondent databox of online media users showed that detik.com was 50% and Kompas.com was 39% in January to February 2024 (Figure 1). Both online media are ranked as the two highest online media that are often used and read by the public [14].

The data sources in this study are news documentation related to protection policies for domestic workers in detik.com and Kompas.com for the 2024 period. The framing used period in 2024, the issue of the domestic worker law began to be discussed again, after 20 years of the domestic worker bill stagnating. The data collection technique uses documentation or archiving of news on detik.com and Kompas.com related to the issue of protection policies for domestic workers.

To make sure the data collected in this research is accurate, relevant, and reliable, a data triangulation technique was used. This technique is used to compare data from various sources such as online media, laws, previous research, and reports from related institutions. Then the data collection technique is a document study that collects and analyzes news related to DW's protection. Technique of determining news samples is purposive sampling which selects news directly or internationally with news criteria involving news about domestic worker protection policies in Indonesia.

The data analysis technique uses framing analysis model by Robert N. Entman, used to find out how a journalist's perspective or selecting issues as well as writing news. The perspective is in the form of what facts will be written, which parts are emphasized or omitted, and where the news will be taken. Four categorization elements, namely define problems, diagnose causes, make moral judgment, and treatment recommendation.

Results and Discussion

In the period of 2024, online media detik.com and Kompas.com appear to be intense in reporting news about government policies on the protection of domestic workers. So news related to the protection policy of domestic workers or the PPRT Bill has an important value to be easily read, remembered by readers, and news penning in the form of criticizing the government which is considered slow in providing government policies. The period of 2024 is considered strategic in reporting on domestic worker protection policies, coincides with the change of legislative members of the DPR RI as the discussant and ratification of the PPRT Bill. Then with the cases that befell domestic workers having a negative effect on the physical as well as psychological, the absence of a legal umbrella in providing protection to victims, and the time of discussion until the ratification of the Law that never found a bright spot after 20 years from the beginning of the formation of the draft law.

Researchers observed that in the period of 2024, especially from July to October 2024, the majority of news about domestic worker protection policies were raised to the surface (see [Table 1](#) and [Table 2](#)). This of course coincides with the retirement of members of the House of Representatives (DPR RI) of the 2019-2024 period who have never provided a bright spot in the PPRT Bill, as well as the replacement of members DPR RI of the 2024-2029 period who have just been inaugurated. The this raises concerns about the PPRT Bill, which is allegedly going to stagnate further due to government's attitude which is considered less assertive. The little of the news made to lead to an

attitude that was considered pessimistic about the policy of the PPRT Bill. Both online media are highlighting, criticizing, and striving for government policy on the ratification of the domestic worker protection bill (PPRT Bill).

The coverage in the two media is similar, namely highlighting the urge to accelerate the ratification of the bill from various parties. Namely the community, affected organizations, and government members. This is channeling of people's aspiring regarding the performance of government policies in accordance with the freedom of opinion and expression in Article 28 and Article 28E paragraph 3 of the 1945 construction. The article states that "everyone has the right to freedom of association, assembly, and expression" [15].

There are similarities in the exposure between the detik.com and Kompas.com portals. The news tends to be the same at the same moment or news event, namely the news of detik.com and Kompas.com portals. The news pattern tends to be the same at the same moment or news event, namely Komnas Perempuan and Komnas HAM concerns about the slow ratification of the impact on the high DW's cases. The news contains almost the same points even though in different periods of time due to no space restrictions that make mass media free to publish news tends to be similar. The similarity of the news appears in the characteristic of mass media, which is a fast and diverse information [16].

The news on detik.com explained the aspirations of House of Representative's slowness in cases that befall DW's many formal and non formal parties encouraged the ratification of the PPRT Bill to be passed immediately. This shows that the news can be used to find out people's aspirations about certain events that have a big impact on society itself through framing [17]. Detik.com tends to focus on its partisanship in the form of aspirations by those demanding the acceleration of the ratification of the PPRT Bill for the impact of the slow ratification of the PPRT Bill. Role of the media is not only to convey information, but also to criticize the government to be called a watchdog. Media supervision that provides credible information to attract attention from stakeholders to participate or break down problems [18].

Meanwhile, Kompas.com framed the news about the performance of the DPR RI which is considered slow in the process. Kompas.com has social democratic ideology that shows its alignment community, which is in accordance with the function of mass media, namely as a social watchdog [13]. The fact that the bill is 20 years old after it was formed,

but has not shown the appropriate results. Contained in the Kompas.com news entitled Civil Society to Puan Maharani; If you care about the people, don't hold the domestic worker protection bill hostage. Criticism was conveyed to the DPR RI, which was considered not serious about continuing and passing bill. The media acts as a forum for criticism of the government to build a relevant government system [19].

The phrase "Does Ms. Puan have partiality and concern for her DW's? We want to question it" shows the element of making a moral judgment on criticism in the form of verbal and mediated technology in the democratic era. Kompas.com shows aspirations in the form of criticism to the government, especially DPR RI, then make a moral judgment as a moral basis for the attitude that a person takes [16]. The frustration and criticism conveyed by JALA PRT to the performance of DPR RI, especially the Speaker of the House Representatives, Puan Maharani, is a form of frustration over the slow pace of government policies.

The statement of criticism in the headline "Urge DPR to Pass PPRT Bill, Komnas HAM: If Not, Domestic Workers remain at Risk" paragraph nine reveals that the PPRT Bill has been proposed to the DPR since 2004 but has not yet been passed into law, the stages that have been in process so far must be repeated from the beginning of the next DPR period. In line with previous research conducted by Choirunnisak, Kompas.com shows real criticism by several parties regarding the performance of preventing and handling the pandemic by the government which is considered not concrete, dangerous, and does not show seriousness [20].

In the first and twelfth news on Kompas.com, it provides a point of view from members of DPR RI Commission XIII and the PKS faction who mediate the bad news about the DPR RI performance, which is considered slow in passing the PPRT Bill through efforts to accelerate the ratification. Which is considered in line with the vision of the current government and the spirit of seeing the same interest by the vision, mission, ideology, and values adopted by the mass media company [10]. This shows that not all members of the DPR RI members have the same enthusiasm and alignment with the people and communities regarding the ratification of the PPRT Bill. Then Kompas.com seeks to emphasize readers through the presence of Kompas.com as a guide amid the swift flow or information whose information is not necessarily guaranteed the truth [21].

Based on the result of the Entman model framing analysis on the news of the draft legislation on the protection of DW's, the result obtained are define problem or the party responsible for this news is the DPR RI. But the difference is that detik.com leads to the urge to immediately pass the PPRT Bill. Kompas.com leads to the performance of the DPR RI which is considered slow in the process of discussing and passing the PPRT Bill through two different points of view. The cases experienced by DW's are the impact of the vulnerable conditions of domestic workers, but there is no law that provides protection until now. The moral message or make a moral judgment on this news is that the vulnerable condition of domestic workers should be special concern to the DPR RI, which has full authority and various other elite parties to achieve equality through legal

protection. And the treatment recommendation or solution offered by detik.com is in the form of investigating cases, supporting cases, supporting victims, and approval in the Prolegnas, while Kompas.com leads to enthusiasm and commitment to discuss and pass the PPRT Bill.

In line with Destiara Hasna Jayanto in her research on the bill on the elimination of sexual violence in the news framing of the Tirto.id portal using Entmant framing analysis. According to her, Tirto.id uses credible and structured source regarding news framing that makes people see the importance of the elimination of the sexual violence bill. Contains the urge to pass the bill and the hope of improving the country's legal system for handling victim's right as diagnosing causes. Make moral judgment related to women in Indonesia who need legal protection, and the abolition of the bill is a deviant act that needs to be taken firm action. And the solution offered is ratification of the Sexual Violence Elimination Bill [22]. This search is similar to our research that dissects news using Entmnat's framing elements, but in this study only uses one online media portal and does not show the parties or actor that are highlighted in the news of the sexual violence elimination bill.

Slightly different from the search from conducted by Imelda Dwi Putri Nainggolan regarding the framing of Puan Maharani's reporting on the issue of work copyright legislation on the Kompas.com and detik.com October 2020 edition. The difference between the two media portals in diagnose causes, namely the choice of vocabulary in delivering news. Kompas.com uses standard sentence accompanied by complete information, while detik.com uses words that are more simple so that they are easy to understand and the use of words with negative connotations [13]. In contrast to the results of the research's research, the research focuses on the information conveyed in the news, while this study looks at the syntactic structure news.

In line with the framing research conducted by Muhammad Alberian Reformansyah on Kompas.com and detik.com. This research result in the case of "IDI is a lackey of WHO" related to violations of the ITE Law on detik.com and Kompas.com into four elements framing Entmant's. Detik.com frames Jenrix as the unable to maintain his critical attitude, meanwhile Kompas.com which provided information on the court's decision and the family's good response to the sentence [16]. This results in search results that seen to be in line with the researcher's research on Entmant's four framing elements in which the two news portals frame different news on the same event, but in this study the topic is about violations ITE Law.

Conclusion

Based on the frame analysis of news on the media portals detik.com and Kompas.com about the government's policy to protect domestic workers, it is clear that role of the media is not only to provide information. However, over time the media as social controllers of the government or related institutions plays a more active role in the political design that affects social interest. The results show that media detik.com and

Kompas.com became information rooms for expressing the hopes and critics of the government policy community to promote the approval of the draft law on the protection of domestic workers.

The discussion above shows the similarity of the aspirations of the community, related organizations, and governments parliament to the DPR RI to attempt to encourage the speedy discussion and ratification of the draft law on the protection domestic workers. However, what distinguishes between the two is the point of view of viewing the news content, detik.com only focus on aspirations triggered by the impact caused by the PPRT Bill not being passed immediately. While Kompas.com more deeply criticizes the performances of the DPR RI which is considered slow, does not provide clarity regarding the discussion of the PPRT Bill, and does not show its partiality to the community. And the Kompas.com portal, two points of view are given through the news delivered by members of the DPR faction as an arbiter of the criticism conveyed to the DPR RI in the form of encouragement in completing the discussion and ratification of the PPRT Bill. Make a moral judgment shows that women domestic workers are classified as vulnerable conditions that should get legal protection by the authorities, namely the DPR RI and other elite parties to achieve equality.

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
